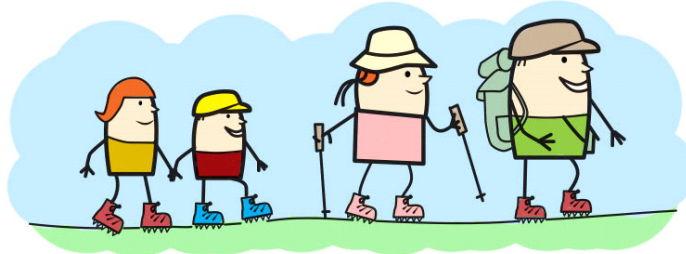


CELEBRATE

**Walk the lanes and footpaths near Hadlow Down parish boundary
with Rev. John.**

Easy sections of 1.6 to 3.4 miles - all ages welcome. Transport from and back to the church will be provided for each section, and refreshments in the church throughout the day from 9.30 am.

Traditionally, Beating the Bounds involved the parish priest walking around the parish boundary and beating it with a stick - hence the name. This year Rev. John is reviving the tradition in Hadlow Down as part of the **Hadlow Down Festival**.

Part 1 from Pound Lane to bottom of Riverside - 2.4 miles approx. start 9.45am.

Part 2 from Riverside to Junction of B2102 / A267 – 2 miles approx. start 11.00am.

Part 3 for safety reasons will be completed by Father John only

Part 4 Skippers Hill to School Lane – 3.4 miles approx. start 12.00 pm.

Part 5 School Lane, across fields into Howbourne Lane and up to A272 – 1.6 miles approx. start 1.45 pm
